

UPRISING 2017 VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Participation as a vendor at the Society of Creative Anachronism (SCA) Inc. event known as Uprising (herein called Uprising War) being held at Mountain View Ranch, Shelley, Idaho, from noon Tuesday June 13, 2017 through noon Sunday June 18, 2017 constitutes agreement with the following rules and regulations. Vendors, their agents, employees and/or affiliations (herein called the Merchant) agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the SCA Inc., the Barony of One Thousand Eyes (a branch of the SCA Inc.), Mountain View Ranch, Uprising War and Uprising Staff (herein called the Host) and the State of Idaho.
2. The Merchant agrees to abide by the Uprising War site rules as published on www.barony1000eyes.org/uprisingwar.
3. Mountain View Ranch, a private property, reserves the right to limit the hours, location and operation of any business on its premises. The Merchant sells at Uprising War by invitation and must conform to the policies established regardless of license.
4. The Host disclaims all liability for damages or losses caused to or by any Merchant by fire, water, flood, windstorm, utility failures, rodents, acts of vandalism, insurrection, civil disorder, strikes, criminal acts, or thefts. The Host will not be responsible for any failure of electric or other services. Merchants wishing to insure their goods must do so at their own expense. The Merchant shall at all times protect, indemnify, save and keep harmless the Host against any and all loss, costs, damages, liability or expenses arising from or out of or by reason of any accident or other occurrence to anyone including the Merchant which arises from or out of by reason or said Merchants occupancy and use of the event premises or a part thereof or out of any act or omission of the Merchant.
5. The Host will not be responsible for loss or damage of any equipment, animals, property or sales. We also cannot control every item each vendor sells. Our interest is to keep each booth unique, some booths will sell similar items, and the Host is not liable in any way for this.
6. Registration gives the Merchant license to sell as an independent operator, not as an employee or agent of the Host. Merchants are required to register their staff and any affiliations and pay all applicable event fees. Merchant and event registration must be submitted together or the merchant registration may be rejected. Merchants may not share booths or registrations. **There are no Merchant Fees.**
7. Submitting registration does not guarantee license as a vendor at Uprising War. The Host grants license only after acceptance. The Host may revoke its approval or refuse to accept any application without reason or cause of any kind. Infractions of the rules may result in withdrawal of vendor license, and or expulsion from Uprising War.
8. Event registration fees for staff and or affiliated persons at Uprising War are \$55.00 per adult (18 or older), \$20.00 per Minor (6 to 17) and \$0.00 per child (under 6) and member discount of \$5.00 for all adults who are current members of the SCA, Inc. Vendor space is limited and space will be assigned as registration forms are received. Vendor registrations must be received by May 15, 2017; late registrations will not be accepted.
9. All Merchants are required to have an Idaho Seller's Permit. A copy of the permit must be on file with the Merchant Steward on or before the first day of Uprising War or you will not be permitted access as a vendor. Visit the [Idaho State Tax Commission web page](#) for information about obtaining a State of Idaho for this Seller's Permit. Food vendors must comply with Idaho health regulations, and make prior arrangements with the Merchant Steward and the Autocrat.
10. The Merchant may be accepted with restrictions or requirements. If the restrictions or requirements are not met the Merchant will be subject to actions including, but not limited to, the closing of the contracted selling site, removal of selling materials, removal of the Merchant, and halting all vending activities at Uprising War without refund of any fees to the Merchant.

11. Merchant **setup starts Tuesday, June 13 at 8 am.** Driving into the vendor area (known as “town square”) to unload is permitted, as long as weather conditions permit. All vehicles must be out of town square as soon as possible. General setup in the main camping area will start Tuesday, June 13 at noon, only vendor setup will be allowed prior to noon.
12. All Merchants should be in full operation by noon on Wednesday, June 14, 2017. Failure to do so may result in loss of your vendor space. Exceptions will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Merchant should remain available for business until the end of business Saturday, June 17, 2017. There will be no selling allowed on Sunday, June 18, 2017.
13. **The Merchant will remove all equipment, supplies, merchandise and trash generated by the merchant by noon Sunday June 18, 2017.** The Merchant assumes responsibility for any hauling charges or other expenses incurred for the disposal and cleanup of the vendor space occupied.
14. The Merchant shall have a sign that is visible to people walking in town square. The sign should clearly indicate your business name and the hours you are open for business. The Host reserves the right to reject the use of offensive names or signs.
15. The Merchant is required to have a fire extinguisher in their booth at all times. Merchants are to conform to the dress of the Middle Ages per SCA requirements and required to have a period looking booth face. Animals must be kept on leash or kenneled. Music inappropriate to the SCA is prohibited in the town square area (i.e. rock and roll and other modern music). All other music or offensive noise will be moderated at your neighbor’s request. Rule of thumb – if it annoys your neighbor, it will annoy the Merchant Steward.
16. It is not our goal to restrict the trade of any vendor; however, if you feel your merchandise may be inappropriate, please contact the Merchant Steward. Merchandise should be medieval and/or “SCA” related. The Host reserves the right to demand removal of any merchandise. Please keep the following products stocked out of view with only a few pieces of merchandise on display: plastic coated slogan buttons and bumper stickers, music tapes, CDs, computer software, etc.
17. **Merchant may not offer for sale or otherwise distribute alcoholic beverages,** subject to immediate eviction from the site.
18. Should the merchant fail to comply with these rules or any portion of this agreement. The Host may take immediate steps, which in their sole judgment may be necessary to protect the interests of Uprising War, including, but not limited to, the closing of the contracted selling site, removal of selling materials, removal of merchant and halting all vending activities at Uprising War without refund of any fees to the merchant.
19. We wish to stress that children of vendors are be subject to the same rules as all other children at the event. Children’s activities are not for babysitting. You will be required to be a parent and are liable for the actions of your children. If your children attend the planned activities you are required to donate ½ hour of your time volunteering at the children’s activities.
20. The Autocrat may contact the Merchant for a donation to the volunteer raffle or other donation, donations are not required. Should any person other than the Merchant Steward contact you for a donation of any kind, please refer him or her to the Autocrat.
21. Full refund will be granted if the Autocrat is notified in writing postmarked 15 days prior to the event. All other requests for refunds will be at the discretion of the Autocrat. There will be no refunds if you are asked to leave the site at the request of the Host.

UPRISING POLICY ON UNDERAGE DRINKING AND ILLEGAL DRUGS

The Merchant acknowledges, understands and endorses the policies and laws of the United States, State of Idaho, Mountain View Ranch, the Barony of One Thousand Eyes, and the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc., on underage drinking and illegal drug use. Specifically, drinking of alcoholic beverages by anyone less than 21 years of age and/or the use of any controlled substances without prescription by any person is unlawful and will not be tolerated on the Uprising site. Any person under 21 years of age who is found drinking alcoholic beverages shall be ejected from the site without refund and turned over to the civil authorities. Any person found using unlawful drugs shall be ejected from the site without refund and turned over to the civil authorities. In addition, if such a person is under 21 years of age, the parents or guardian shall also be ejected from the site without refund. Furthermore, at the sole discretion of the Seneschal, the Autocrat, and/or the Vicar of One Thousand Eyes, any person they deem to have aided, abetted, or contributed to such underage drinking shall be ejected from the site without refund and turned over to the civil authorities.

I have read and understand the “Uprising Vendor Rules and Regulations” and “Uprising Policy on Underage Drinking and Illegal Drugs” and agree to abide by all the above-mentioned rules and hold all agents and affiliations to the same.

Instructions for registration

1. Do not alter form in any way. Alterations to this form could invalidate pre-registration.
2. All registrations that include minors **must** also include their legal guardian. If you are registering a minor for whom you are not the parent or legal guardian, you must provide proper waivers. See <http://www.sca.org/docs/library.html> for copies of waivers.
3. Ensure that the member discount is applied to all persons who are current members or the SCA age 18 or older.
4. Proof of membership will be checked at gate upon sign-in. Please note that if proof of membership is not provided when you arrive on site, we must charge the additional \$5.00, even if you are a member! Approved forms of proof of membership include membership card and membership letter from SCA including web site printout. Please do not send proof of membership with these forms.
5. Make payment by check or money order or other certified funds (do not send cash!) to "The Barony of One Thousand Eyes, SCA, Inc."
6. Checks and money orders will be processed upon receipt. There will be a \$20 charge for returned checks. Enclose payment (check or money order), and all forms, with correct postage, and mail to:
